

MD-19 GLT Report – Debbie Bostock

October Oct. 3rd, 2025

Work is currently underway to organize seminars in Wenatchee for the District Governors (DGs), 1st and 2nd Vice District Governors (VDGs), Zone Chairs, and Global Action Team (GAT) members who will serve in the 2026-27 year. Approval has been granted for a Leadership Grant specifically for VDG training in Wenatchee. In addition, District I has successfully secured approval for a Zone Chair (ZC) grant, also to be held in Wenatchee.

District O has submitted an application for this grant, but as of now, no confirmation has been received regarding its approval. Information about the grants and application process was distributed to District Governors, District Governors-elect, and Global Leadership Team (GLT) members in June to encourage timely applications.

GLT members from each District are requested to provide the names of all participants in any officer training sessions conducted within their areas. Notably, District L held an officer training session on 2025-08-30. District N organized officer training for Zones 9, 10, and 11 on 2025-09-13. Additionally, officers from the Camas Lions Club have completed their training.

One ongoing challenge is the inability to enter participants or presenters from the U.S. side of the border into the system. While District GLT members have the capability to enter this information, it remains uncertain whether international Districts are able to do so for the U.S. side. This issue was escalated to Lions Clubs International (LCI) last year, but a solution is still pending.

I am holding monthly GTL meetings on the 4th Tuesday of each month.
