## CLUB WEBSITE AWARD RULES

Club Websites entered in this Contest are the winners, or in the case where the winners are unable to compete, the runners-up of the respective contests held at the District level. *The District Governor shall submit the name of the District winner and runner up to the MD19 Contests and Awards Chairperson and the MD19 Office within 30 days of his/her District Spring Conference.*

### JUDGING WILL BE BASED ON:

1. Site Look and Feel ..... 30 Possible Points
  - a. Is the site easy to read?
  - b. Do the colors on the site allow for ease of reading?
  - c. Are the graphics, images & pictures clear & sized appropriately?
  - d. Animation, multimedia, or interactive components?
  - e. Information on officers & contacts easily found?
  - f. Does every page have a link back to the home page?
  - g. Each page topic specific?
  - h. Is information categorized for ease of use?
  - i. Is overall site layout neat, organized & efficient to navigate?
  
2. Information and Content ..... 30 Possible Points
  - a. Site updated since July 1?
  - b. Is all information on site current?
  - c. Is there a link to the MD19 Website?
  - d. Do all of the links work?
  - e. Information for contacting club (zone or district) leadership?
  - f. Is the site listed on LionNet.com under the appropriate country section and with a working link?
  
3. Over-all Perception ..... 40 Possible Points

- a. Is there an email link or other method to contact the site web master?
- b. Does the site prominently display the Lions International Emblem on the home page?
- c. Please rate your overall feeling and experience with this site.
