UNIFORM PARADE AWARD RULES
(Formerly known as Uniformed Delegation Award)

1. A club's membership must be dressed in the same or similar manner to participate in the contest.
2. Spouses, Lady Lions, Lioness, or Leos may be included as part of the uniform parade. Lioness and Leos may compete as a separate group if they do not compete with their sponsoring Lions Club.
3. Judging will take place at the Fall Annual Convention.
4. Clubs must have two or more members marching in uniform to be eligible for judging in the Uniform parade.

Any club who has only one member in the parade will be included as part of one group at the end of the judged entries. Individual entrants will not be judged and neither will the group as a whole, but they can participate in the parade if they wish, for the fun and fellowship of it.

5. In selecting the winner, judges will consider the suitability of uniform for other than convention wear, such as, visitations, etc. In the event of a tie, the judges may consider the distance traveled to the convention.
